

DEVICE MENU (updated 2/25/21)

- Bob**
“Tried and True”
Shotgun type: hole in left side of stem
Bowl type: Glass; rubber stopper
Screening: Small titanium strainer
Coolant level: ½ ” below stopper hole; just below widest part of reservoir
In-use maintenance: dump ashes; carefully scrape strainer with point of small nail (once strainer fully seated)
Between-use maintenance: Grunge Off soak/hot water rinse; REQUIRES ISS
- Blue Angled Bob (BAB)**
“Known to dribble”
Shotgun type: spring-loaded in-stem
Bowl type: metal standard; threaded to stem
Screening: Large titanium strainer
Coolant level: undetermined
In-use maintenance: dump ashes; carefully scrape strainer with point of small nail
Between-use maintenance: Disassemble bowl/stem; solvent soak/scrub; hot water/soap rinse; hot water rinse
- Big Mouth Bob**
“Talks with a loud voice, and carries a big stick”
Shotgun type: hole in stem
Bowl type: Glass; lift-out
Screening: Large titanium strainer
Coolant level: ¼” below “Roc kville, MD” labeling on back
In-use maintenance: dump ashes; scrape strainer with head of 8d nail (once strainer fully seated)
Between-use maintenance: Grunge Off soak/hot water rinse; reinsert strainer
- Diablo Rojo**
“Short and squat”
Shotgun type: spring-loaded in-stem
Bowl type: metal standard; threaded to stem
Screening: Large titanium strainer
Coolant level: 2 cubes, 3 glass vials (or 4 ½ vials total)
In-use maintenance: dump ashes; carefully scrape strainer with point of small nail
Between-use maintenance: Disassemble bowl/stem; solvent soak/scrub; hot water/soap rinse; hot water rinse
- Graffix Bob**
“Thanks Dr. Dave”
Shotgun type: none
Bowl type: Glass; lift-out
Screening: Small titanium strainer
Coolant level: approximately ½” below rubber bushing; crushed ice strongly recommended over cubes
In-use maintenance: dump ashes; scrape strainer with head of 8d nail (once strainer fully seated)
Between-use maintenance: Grunge-off for glass bowl; other specifics unknown (plastic body)
- Beach Bob (BeB) (currently on vacation)**
“X”
Shotgun type: none
Bowl type: metal standard; hand grip; easily removable
Screening: Small titanium strainer?
Coolant level: undetermined?
In-use maintenance: dump ashes;
Between-use maintenance: Grunge-off for glass bowl; other specifics unknown (plastic body)
- Short ‘n’ Sweet**
Shotgun type: none
Bowl type: Presumably Glass; lift-out
Screening: n/a
Coolant level: approximately ½” below rubber bushing; crushed ice strongly recommended over cubes
In-use maintenance: dump ashes; scrape strainer with head of 8d nail (once strainer fully seated)
Between-use maintenance: Grunge Off soak/hot water rinse; REQUIRES ISS
- The Scientist**
“Mr. Erlenmeyer to you”
Shotgun type: n/a
Bowl type: Glass; rubber stopper
Screening: Small titanium strainer
Coolant level: ½ ” below stopper hole
In-use maintenance: dump ashes; carefully scrape strainer with point of small nail (once strainer fully seated)
Between-use maintenance: Grunge Off soak/hot water rinse; REQUIRES ISS

1/16/21 CDC Report re Pocket Protocol (PP)

- Once a standard Bic lighter weighs in at less than 17.00g, it enters Pocket Protocol (PP)
- The lighter must be kept in a person's inside pocket for at least 5 minutes before being used.
 - The coif should be closely examined to ensure consistency so as to provide full burning if a PP lighter gives out mid-B.
 - A spare lighter should be within arm's reach prior to any attempt at placing a PP lighter in service.
 - A lighter may not leave PP unless it has been kept in a person's inside pocket for at least 30 minutes before being used, and has failed to complete a B. That lighter should be weighed, labeled, and added to the archives.

1/30/21 Report re Snow B's

- Place smoking device in freezer (or refrigerator) for at least 15 minutes, after first removing stem from device. Check condition/placement of screen/strainer.
- Assemble large bowl for snow, glove(s), lighter, coiffer and cheese.
- Using glove(s), fill snow bowl with the freshest & fluffiest snow you can find. Transfer from bowl to device, packing as full as reasonable without risking damage to the device. If undue delay is expected, transfer device to freezer (or refrigerator) until ready.
- Remove glove(s), dry hands, and prepare coiff in conventional fashion in a separate bowl.
- Transfer coiff to smoking device.
- Please note that Device Menu standards for snow amounts have not been determined, and coolant amount is at the complete discretion of the user.
