## **Facilities Rules**

- F1) HQ is considered open at 6PM, unless otherwise announced.
- F2) Changes of venue should be announced 48 hours in advance.
- F3) Gamers 1-5 should notify HQ 48 hours in advance if they will not be in attendance. Higher numbered gamers are encouraged to do so.
- F4) Beverages that cross the threshold may not leave the premises in the same container.
- F5) Numbers are encouraged to avail themselves of any of the wide variety of non-alcoholic beverages. Keep your hands off the Proprietor's beer. Cooling facilities are available for storing any of the Numberships' beverages between meetings.
- F6) If you spill a beverage, or can realistically be blamed for contributory spillage, and don't have a towel or napkin, you're licking it up.
- F7) If a Terps Men's basketball game is on live TV, or is being live-streamed, against a Division I team, there shall be no gaming on the MGT unless there is either:
  - a) a point differential of 30 at the half
  - b) a point differential of 20 with less than 10 minutes in regulation
  - c) unanimous consent of Numbership present
- F8) Numbers are responsible for ensuring that their tax payments are properly recorded.
- F9) At least one ceiling fan must be running when a doobie is lit, or when at least one of the Numbership believes it should be.
- F10) Upon arrival (if there is no outdoor congregation), Numbers are permitted to stroll right in the front door, but are expected to indicate their arrival by ringing the doorbell or knocking on the door prior to doing so. Numbers are permitted to slip in with a returning congregation without so indicating.
- F11) Exterior doors should not be unlocked without the express permission of the Proprietor.
- F12) There is no automatic right to self-re-entry to the premises.

### **Munchies Rules**

# M1) Chips:

- a) When serving chips, multiple bowls shall be used; the bowls shall be as nearly identical in appearance as possible. Each bag of chips shall be substantially equally distributed between the bowls.
- b) Subject to availability, multiple bags of the same kind of chips shall not be served together, nor back-to-back. Different flavors of the same kind of chip count as "same" for purposes of the first clause of the first sentence of subsection b, but do not count as "same" for the purposes of the second clause of said sentence.
- c) Subject to availability, if 3 or more chips bags are selected, at least one should be Cheetos or Cheezelt (hereinafter Cchips); however, rule M1b has precedence. If 2 chips bags are selected, it is strongly urged that one of them be a Cchip.

# M2) Popcorn:

- a) When serving popcorn, multiple bowls shall be used. The smallest bowl shall be filled first, with the topping added separately. The topping selected for the larger bowl shall be added to the popcorn bag; the bag shall be shaken, then the contents shall be poured into the larger bowl.
- M3) No "cherry picking" the good stuff out of the bowl of trail mix.
- M4) The hen only holds dark chocolate.
- M5) If in doubt as to bowl selection, refer to the picture on the TeA provisions cabinet door.

# **Gaming Rules**

- G1) Whoever is sitting on the sofa (or closest to the sofa) is dealer. If multiple gamers are tied for this honor, figure it out yourselves.
- G2) Winner cleans it up, Maggot(ess). Loser chooses the next game.
- G3) If you accidentally draw multiple cards, and see the wrong card, you keep the one you saw, not the one you should have drawn.
- G4) Unless otherwise accounted beforehand, when rolling to go first, highest roll goes first (and play proceeds clockwise); lowest roll picks color (and choice proceeds in order of increasing number).
- G5) When multiple table gaming is in effect, those at a table wishing to start a fresh game must check with those at other table(s) to determine estimated time of completion, with an eye towards intermixing of numbers.

- G6) If a valid Big Loser has picked a specific game to be played on the MGT, that game must be filled first before a secondary game may commence.
- G7) Whoever takes the second to last card shuffles the deck (if applicable).
- G8) If scoring by hand on a sheet of paper, also include the name of the game and the date, especially if Uno and Chicken Foot are involved.
